Excel 97, 2000, XP, 2003

A conditional statement of the following form is used to check the pupil's answer against the correct value.

=IF(pupil answer=(value1 OPERATION value2),"J",IF(F1="", "K", "L"))

Example

The formula required for the last cell is as follows:

=IF(F1=(B1*D1),"J",IF(F1="", "K", "L"))

The font for the last cell is Wingdings, where J = ☺, K = ☹ and L = ☹
